Chili contest rules

1. Contestants must register their chili. You can pre-register online at www.stcat.org or by submitting this form.
2. Contestants must sign-in at the check-in table upon arrival. Chili must be dropped-off on Saturday, April 30, 2022 at the parish hall between 6:30pm-7:00pm (with entry form already completed and checked-in). No chili will be entered after 7:00pm. Please note, contestants must have a ticket if entering the event venue.
3. Chili must be prepared in advance.
4. Chili must be warm upon arrival (Please note, we cannot wait to heat up cold chili).
5. Contestants must prepare minimum 2 quarts of chili and bring it in a plug-in crock pot or slow cooker type pot.
6. Eating utensils such as: bowls, spoons and napkins will be provided by SCL PTO.
7. Specialty condiments/toppings are NOT allowed for judging. Eg: No corn bread, sour cream, etc... There is no room on the tables for extra condiments/toppings/sides etc.
8. Committee will prepare the serving cups and serve it to the judges.
9. Judging will take place between 7:00pm-7:30pm.
10. Judges will be given a spoonful of chili and will fill out a judging ballot.
11. Contestant names will not be revealed until after the judging.
12. After winner is announced, chili will available to all attendees for consumption.

- Color—5 points
- Aroma—5 points
- Texture—5 points
- Flavor—5 points
- Heat—5 points
- Overall Impression —5 points
- **Total of 30 points**
